Qu 1:- Can you please inform me of the full cost incurred by the PCC in relation to the case brought for judicial review by the former Chief Constable Mr David Crompton.

Qu 2:- I would be grateful for the costs incurred by the PCC and the costs awarded against him as a result of losing the case.

RESPONSE

Qu 1:- A statement was released into the public domain on the 7th June 2017 (please see below link); which stated:- 'The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner has incurred legal costs of £72K for the Section 38 process. As of the 7th June 2017 an additional £85K in legal fees has been invoiced to the office for the Judicial Review'.
